- 5. If you have more than one child, the Madrasah will attempt to have them in the same shift (to ease of travel concerns); depending on availability.
- 6. Fees will be payable in full at the <u>beginning of each month</u> (within the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month).
- 7. Fees are currently set at £25 per month per child. Late payment (later than 5 days after the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month) will incur a £5 administration fee.
- 8. Fees payable by cash or bank transfer. Bank details will be provided.
